Following a very thorough selection process and accompanied by Archdeacon Peter Hooper, we are pleased to be able to publish the official announcement below regarding the position of House for Duty priest within our chaplaincy.

The Bishop in Europe is pleased to announce that he has offered the post of Chaplain to The Anglican Chaplaincy of Pas-de-Calais to the Revd Teena Twelves,

I would particularly like to give thanks to those who have been part of this discernment process. Thanks also to all who have worked so hard in keeping the mission and ministry activities of the Chaplaincy on-going. I would also ask that you hold Teena in your prayers as she brings to an end her ministry in the Diocese of Canterbury and prepares to come to join us in France."

We will shortly be assisting Teena in finding suitable accommodation in the Boulogne area and look forward to welcoming her to our chaplaincy sometime during Advent.

Which administers and carries out the charitable work of the Pas de Calais chaplaincy. Our Chaplaincy is a religious association (1905 association cultuelle), and therefore is unable to give charitable donations but is permitted to receive them. The work of the Solidarité Anglicane is vital to ensure that the chaplaincy is supporting the local community and is an important part of our outreach and charitable giving. Each year, the three congregations choose a charity each to support, with the aim of raising an amount equivalent to 10% of the chaplaincy's annual income. Currently, the three charities are Calais Lifeboats (SNSM), L'Arche des 3 Fontaines in Audresselles and FIAC (Foyer International des l'Accueil et de Culture) in Berck. As President of the 1901 association, I am delighted to announce that following this year's AGM, we were able to send a cheque for 300 euros to each of our three charities thanks to the great fundraising efforts of our congregations during 2024. Fundraising events included a quiz, a Christmas market stall, an annual carol service and a book sale. We also sent 120 euros to the Royal British Legion from our poppy collection at the Remembrance service. Thank you to all who have given their time to help in so many different ways to raise funds for these worthwhile causes.
